Brief outline of Learning Journey:

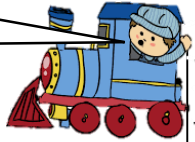
This journey teaches children about their school and local area. It compares life in Victorian Britain to our current lives today.

English

What was life like for different children in Victorian times? How did some key people help to improve living conditions?

Design technology

Introducing basic sewing (Victorian primers).
Designing a supermarket sandwich.

PE

Wednesdays - PE coaches, throwing catching, basic skills.

Fridays - Hall, co-ordination, agility, static balances. (Themes: juggling, fairy-tale, squirrel, cat.)

Maths

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Halves and quarters
- Describing using 'turns'
- Partitioning + comparing numbers (to 100)
- Recognising + using coins and notes
- Telling the time: o'clock and half-past



Art & Design

Learning styles of sketching and drawing including silhouettes. Some painting, modelling and mixed material collage.

Music

Latin American music, Western Classical music and a focus on recognising and placing music introduced this year.

Science

Identifying and classifying plant parts and animal types, plus recapping previous work in Science and considering Victorian inventions.

RE

Exploring the Sikh ceremony of **Naam Karan** and the Sri Lankan festival of **Esala Perahera**.

Computing

Learning to retrieve information and arrange it using presentations.

Jigsaw- Lifeskills

'Relationships' - families + friends.
'Changing Me' - lifecycles + physical changes.
