In Our assemblies this week, we have been thinking about our achievements and many children shared things that they had achieved over the weekend. It's been another busy week in all of our classes:

Class celebrations

Year R- In Year R they have learnt new scientific words to group animals- mammals, reptiles and birds. The children were careful observational artists drawing animals as scientists. Mrs Ford was very impressed.

Year 1- Year 1 have started learning about the Victorians, they had a great first lesson and made some posters about Queen Victoria.

Year 2- Year 2 have worked really hard this week on their information leaflets about Hampton Court Palace. They wrote factual sentences that they had remembered and created some beautiful covers.

Year 3 - Amazing work in Design Technology this week. On Wednesday the children explored lots of different mechanisms including levers, sliders, axles, wheels and cams. 
Stay safe on YouTube using the instructions on Restricted Mode, Blocking & Reporting below.



Restricted Mode







Turn on restricted mode filtering with these simple instructions:

On your home screen tap on your profile picture in the top right corner.



Scroll down and tap on





Swipe the tab to the right to activate Restricted Mode.

Block





Block a user using these simple instructions:



Underneath the user's video select their profile picture.



On the user's profile select in the top right corner.

Select Block user & then select Block again. Report



Report a video using these simple instructions: Select the video you want to report and then tap





Select on Report user.

Select your reason for reporting that video and submit.
