Class celebrations

Year R- Have been using their phonics really well this week to read and write words in sentences. Well done!

Year 1- In writing this week, the children have been very engaged in our new book, the Pirates next door. They made predictions about what they thought would happen in the story, answered comprehension, questions about what they had read so far and drew some brilliant pictures of the characters.

Year 2- Well done year 2 for working so hard on your reading comprehension skills. Fantastic!

Year 3 - Have been working very hard in Science this week. They have been exploring shadows, thinking about how shadows are formed when a light source is blocked by an opaque object. They

have also been learning about the differences of opaque, translucent and transparent. They have made careful observations and thinking about similarities and differences.

Year 4- Well done year 4 for 'starting to get your teeth into the metaphysical round bread that is Ancient Egypt'. They remembered lots of facts about the ancient Egyptian way of life.











Year 3 investigate light and shadows

We will be changing to green PE shorts for all children from September so if you are purchasing new shorts, please buy the green ones rather than red. Red can still be worn until they need to be replaced.



Internet Safety



have you been checking what your child is doing online?

Remember you, as parents, play a vital part in online safety and safeguarding your children from the dangers that they may encounter online.

Talk to them regularly about what they are doing and if possible join in.

Does your child play Minecraft? Make sure they are doing it safely- have a look at the information below:

Minecraft



Minecraft is a multiplatform game where players explore created worlds and use building blocks alongside their imagination to customise these worlds. Users break existing blocks and use them to build and explore the different Minecraft environments. This means that other players can create whatever they want, which could lead to younger players coming across offensive content while exploring these random online worlds.

Stay safe on Minecraft using the instructions on muting, reporting & blocking below:









Mute

Mute all messages within the Chat Settings:





Tap on at the top of your screen.

Tap on

Swipe the tab to the right so it appears green. This will then turn on 'Mute All Chat'.

Block

Block players using these simple instructions:

On the users profile scroll down to Block. Swipe

to the right until it appears green























The player is now blocked. Report

Report players using these simple instructions:

On the users profile tap on Report.

Explain why you are reporting or select an issue from the list provided.

Tap on Report again.
