Our Vision for French at our school

From Year 3 all pupils will learn French, usually as part of their weekly timetable. Over the 4 years of Key Stage 2, pupils will build up their confidence in speaking, listening and writing another language. At North Mundham we aim to make the learning of a language fun and engaging by using relevant resources, cross curricular links, songs and rhymes to support their learning.

Children in our school will learn..

- about the grammatical structure of another language.
- about the way of life of another country.
- the way French is spoken and words are pronounced.
- how to greet and ask questions of a native French speaker.

All children will have the opportunity to..

- hear stories in French
- present their ideas to their peers and others.
- engage in short conversations and express opinions in French.
- make links in languages.
- progress through a range of topics and vocabulary.



We enrich the curriculum by...

- having school wide 'celebrate your culture day'.
- inviting French speaking visitors into school.
- having some language enrichment days.

A North Mundham Leaver will..

- have developed confidence to speak French in a range of situations.
- have developed confidence to 'have a go' at speaking French.
- understand that the phonetics of languages are different.
- be able to pronounce some words clearly in French.
- understand some basic French grammar.
- be able to make links between French and English (and other languages for EAL pupils).
- know several songs and rhymes to help them to remember French vocabulary.
- be able to hold a short conversation in French.
